



Dunbrody Archers Code of Conduct for All Members

This code of behaviour addresses the appropriate level of behaviour, practice and conduct required from all our members.

Everyone involved in Dunbrody Archers should accept the roles and responsibilities that they undertake as we commit ourselves to maintaining an **enjoyable and safe** environment for all. The safe guarding of our members will always be a key priority as we recognise that the welfare of all members is of paramount importance in our club.

We wish to see this code developed, promoted and implemented as an initiative that encourages fair play, respect, equal opportunities and safety for all involved in the association

All members of **Dunbrody Archers** are entitled to;

- Be safe and feel safe
- Be treated with dignity, sensitivity and respect
- Participate in archery on an equal basis, appropriate to their ability and stage of development
- Be happy, have fun and enjoy archery
- Make a complaint in an appropriate way and have it dealt with through a proper and effective complaints procedure
- Be afforded appropriate confidentiality
- Be listened to and to be believed
- Having a voice in the running of their club
- Be protected from abuse

ALL MEMBERS must be encouraged to realise that they have responsibilities to treat fellow archers, trainers and volunteers with the same degree of fairness and respect In this regard all members in Dunbrody Archers agree to:

- Abide by the rules
- Respect opponents; regardless of ability, ethnic origin, cultural background or religion. They are not the enemies, they are partners in a sporting event
- Respect all fellow archers and support them when they do well and when things go wrong
- Treat archers from minority groups with the same respect you show to other people
- Be modest in victory and be gracious in defeat- BE A SPORT
- Approach your clubs Child Protection Officer with any questions or concerns they might have in relation to junior members. Coaches and parents should encourage children to speak out and support them in doing so

- Take due care of your club's equipment and fellow archer's equipment

All Members of Dunbrody Archers must NOT

- Cheat
- Use abusive language or argue with shoot / club officials, club mates or opponents
- Use violence
- Use unfair or bullying tactics to gain advantage or isolate other archers
- Tell lies about fellow archers
- Spread rumours
- Take banned substances to improve performance
- Keep secrets about any person who may have caused them harm
- Use unacceptable language or racial and /or sectarian references
- Behave in any manner that would bring the name of the club or associations they are affiliated to into disrepute

BULLYING OF ANY DESCRIPTION, VERBAL, PHYSICAL OR OTHERWISE IS UNACCEPTABLE AND WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
